Adult Leader Application Process

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Philmont Crew Adviser. Please review all of the attached information before applying for a position.

- Each adult should complete the entire application, including signing the application and return the completed form to the council office Volunteer Service Desk. All applications will be submitted to the Philmont Contingent selection committee.
- Upon receipt of the application, an Interview Scheduling Letter will be sent to the applicant. This will occur in early summer. All adult applicants will be interviewed and selected by July 2005. You will be notified of the interview dates and times.
- No payment is needed at this time. A payment of \$200.00 will be expected immediately after being notified of your selection as a 2006 council contingent adviser.
- Payments can be made by cash, checks made payable to BSA, Mastercard, Visa, Discover or American Express.
- Payment statements will be mailed to each selected adult.

Leader Qualifications

Crew Adviser/Assistant Crew Adviser:

- Be at least 21 years of age (Adviser) and 18 years of age (Assistant Adviser) by July 1, 2006.
- Have served actively in an adult troop leadership position for at least one year during the two-year period prior to July 1, 2006.
- Completed basic New Leaders Essentials, Scoutmaster Specific and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.
- Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness and meet all of the Philmont Scout Ranch medical requirements.
- Compete the 90-minute Youth Protection Training.
- Complete training for valid Basic Red Cross First Aid and CPR certification cards.
- Be approved by the local council.
- Be flexible and a team player.
- Although not required, Wood Badge and/or Scouter's Key are desirable qualifications.
- Have participated in the Philmont training experiences including three pre-trek hikes and monthly crew advisers meetings.
